

5. Summary and Conclusions

- 5.1 This ES Addendum has been prepared to address the information request from DfI Rivers for a Drainage Assessment to be provided.
- 5.2 The Drainage Assessment prepared has since been reviewed by the project ecologist due to the hydrological connectivity between the application site and Lough Neagh and Lough Beg SPA/RAMSAR. Following this review process, it was considered necessary to reassess the drainage proposals and update the Appropriate Assessment previously provided.
- 5.3 This ES Addendum has confirmed that the conclusions of the ES and subsequent further environmental information submissions remain valid insofar as:
- There will be no unacceptable adverse impact on nature conservation interests; and
 - The proposed site is not at risk of flooding and the proposed development will not cause or exacerbate flooding elsewhere.
- 5.4 In response to a third party representation received, this ES Addendum has also clarified that the transport and air quality assessments previously provided remain robust insofar as they have accounted for the quantum and routing of IBA and APCr leaving the site.
- 5.5 This ES Addendum also sets out the up-to-date position on disposal/recovery methods available to the applicant for IBA and APCr and confirms that any disposal/recovery will take place only at a licensed facility authorised for such disposal/recovery. Provided that IBA and APCr are disposed/recovered of at permitted facilities, no significant environmental effects of disposal/recovery are anticipated, beyond those already assessed as part of the permit granting process
